1. This petition has been preferred for a direction to the respondents to convene a DPC for promotion to the post of Assistant Accounts Officer in the establishment of Janpad Panchayat, Palari, District Baloda Bazar-Bhatapara.
2. It is stated that the said post is lying vacant since long and no steps have been taken for convening DPC, despite the fact that the papers have moved from one table to another.
3. The documents filed along with the writ petition shows that the Additional Collector, District Baloda Bazar-Bhatapara has already nominated the Deputy Collector to be formed the Member of DPC, however, the DPC is not being convened.

4. Considering the limited prayer made in this writ petition and in view of the provisions contained in Rule 19 of the Chhattisgarh Panchayat Service (Recruitment and General Conditions of Services) Rules, 1999 (for short 'the Rules, 1999'), the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to examine the matter and if promotional post is available in the cadre of Assistant Accounts Officer and there is need for filling the post, the DPC shall be convened, in accordance with the Rules, 1999, at the earliest, preferably within a period of six months from the date of submission of certified copy of this order.
