1. Petitioner herein filed MCRC(a) No. 173/2017  
before this Court for grant of anticipatory bail  
in connection with Crime No. 117 of 2017. It is

moved an application before the Additional

3.If the petitioner has submitted his mobile phone along with the application filed by him before this Court i.e. MCRC(a) No. 173/2017, no writ can be issued to the respondent – High Court for the return of the said mobile phone to the petitioner. 4.With the aforesaid liberty reserved in favour of the petitioner, this writ petition stands disposed of. No cost(s).
