The grievance of the petitioner is that though the petitioner had moved an application before respondent No.1 on 03.06.2019 for grant of regular stage carriage permit on the route Shish to Bilaspur via Pali, Pondi, Sillimond, Ratanpur and one return trip daily, however, the application has remained pending without any decision.
3. Learned counsel for the State submits that the application of the petitioner shall be considered and disposed off as early as possible.
