The present revision is directed against the impugned order dated 10.07.2019 passed by the Second Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Raipur in MJC No. 393/18 whereby the court below has granted interim maintenance of Rs. 4,000 & 1000/- in favour of the respondents.

2. Contention of the counsel for the applicant is that the respondent has left the company of the applicant voluntarily without there being any sufficient reason and for that also she is not entitled to

receive any maintenance from him. He submits that the order impugned is apparently illegal and without considering the submissions of the applicant, the order has been passed.

3. In the facts and circumstances of the case, the present revision is disposed of with a direction to the Family Court to decide the main case itself as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

4. It is made clear that if any delay occurs on behalf of the non-applicants, then the trial court shall reconsider the application for interim maintenance. Revision is accordingly dismissed with the aforesaid direction.
