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**Hon'ble Shri Justice P. Sam Koshy****Order on Board****05/09/2019**

1. The claim of the petitioner in the instant writ petitions is that the petitioner is working with the respondents for more than three decade now and respondents till date have not considered the claim of the petitioners for regularization.
2. The contention of the petitioners is that, let petitioners be permitted to make representation in this regard to respondent No. 1 & 2 and respondent No. 1 & 2 in turn may decide the representation of the petitioners in accordance with the circular of the State Government dated

05.03.2008 and all subsequent circulars issued by the State Government.

3. The limited prayer which the petitioner has made is not opposed by the State counsel.
4. Accordingly, the writ petition stand disposed off with a direction that petitioners shall make a detailed representation supported with all relevant records, circulars and notifications of the State Government within a period of three weeks from today and respondent No. 2 & 3 in turn may decide the representations of the petitioner within a further period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of representations which shall be filed by the petitioners.
5. The writ petition stand accordingly disposed of.
