1. The Appellant has moved this Court with the following prayers:

2. The issue is with regard to the transfer of the Appellant from Primary Health Centre, Gogaon, Block Dharsiwa to Primary Health Center, Khairkhunt, Block-Tilda, District Raipur (C.G.) where interference was declined by the learned Single Judge, and hence the appeal.
