1. The challenge in the present Writ Petition is to the impugned order
Annexure P-1 dated 23.08.2019, whereby the petitioner has been
transferred from the Office of Block Medical Officer, Durgukondal,
District: Kanker to District Hospital, Sukma, District: Sukma, (C.G.).
2. The ground of challenge is that, the petitioner has been transferred
from a core schedule area to another core schedule area which is in
contravention to the transfer policy of the State Government.
3. The counsel for the petitioner, on a query being put to the petitioner,
he fairly admits that in the district Kanker, he has already worked for
some considerable period of time.

4. Given the aforesaid facts, that, the petitioner has worked for considerable time in the same district. This Court does not find the impugned order of transfer to be bad-in-law. So far as the transfer of petitioner from a core schedule area to another core schedule area. It is directed that the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner, if the petitioner makes a representation in this regard for posting him to a non-schedule area as per the transfer policy of the State.
5. Let this exercise be done/concluded as per the Transfer Policy within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of representation of the petitioner in this regard.
6. Accordingly, the present Writ Petition stands disposed off.
