The appeal is in respect of the judgement dated 11.09.2019 whereby the writ petition filed by the Appellant with regard to transfer of the Petitioner was finalized based on the submission made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner. The grievance is with regard to transfer of the Petitioner as per Annexure P/1 from ITI Korba to ITI Kurud, District Dhamtari.

When the matter came up for consideration before this Court, it was submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that the Petitioner might be permitted to file a representation to the Respondents with her grievance and the same might be directed to be considered within a time frame. The said prayer was granted by the learned Single Judge and the matter was finalized accordingly.
