1. This is the first bail application under Section 439 of the CrPC and there is no bail application is pending before any other Court.
2. The applicant has been arrested in connection with Crime No.353/2018 registered in Police Station City Kotwali, District Dhamtari (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 307, 456 of IPC.
3. Argument heard.
4. Case of the prosecution, in brief is that on 01/08/2018 about 8 p.m. at Amapara in the house of the complainant, applicant entered in her house, pour the kerosene oil on complainant and tried to burn her by matchbox.
5. Counsel for the applicant submits that he has innocent and falsely implicated in the present case.
6. Counsel for the State submits that there is no antecedents of the applicant is reported in police case diary.
7. Looking to the above facts and circumstances of the case, the application is allowed. It is directed that if the applicant furnishes one solvent surety for a sum of Rs. 25,000/- along with one personal bond of Rs. 25,000/- to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, he be released on bail.
