1. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent No.2 the Returning Officer of the election of Gymnastics Federation of India has published a voter list (Annexure P/2) whereby there is no representation on behalf of the State of Chhattisgarh shown as no Gymnastic association was found eligible.
2. The contention of the petitioner is that he has a document in his favour which shows the affiliation letter dated 31.08.2018 issued by the Gymnastics Federation of India. This non-inclusion of the petitioner has been opposed by the petitioner by filing an objection before the respondents No.1 & 2.

3. Given the said facts, this Court is of the opinion that ends of justice would serve if the respondents No.1 & 2 are directed to consider the objection that the petitioner has made so far as his non-representation of the petitioner in the upcoming election.
4. It is expected that they shall take a decision on the objection before the elections are conducted.
5. With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
