1. The prayers are under following terms:

“(i) That, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to call the entire record from the concern respondent authorities.

(ii) That, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the concern respondent authorities (Collector Dantewada & Collector Beejapur) may be taken appropriate step to relive the respondent Nos. 9 & 10 in their transferred places within specific period in compliance of the transfer order dated 23.08.2019 (Annexure P/1) issued by Respondent No. 2.

(iii) Any other relief, which may be deemed, fit by this Hon'ble Court just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may also be provided in favor of the petitioner.”

2. On raising a query as to whether public interest litigation will lie in view of the nature of prayer, which is more in relation to a service matter, the learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner seeks for permission to withdraw the matter.

3. Permission is granted.

4. The writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
