1. This is the first bail application under Section 439 of the CrPC and there is no bail application is pending before any other Court.
2. Perused the case diary provided by the learned counsel for the State in connection with the Crime No.115/2018 registered at Police Station Bhilai Bhatti, District Durg (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 420, 467, 468, 419, 201 of IPC.
3. Case of the prosecution, in brief is that on applicant had obtained a cheque for sum of Rs. 360/- from the complainant Sanjay Sahu to publish the advertisement in Dainik Bhaskar newspaper. He had also obtained a cheque from Naresh Traders, Tatibandh Raipur for sum of Rs.360/-. Thereafter he manipulated the cheque of Naresh Traders changed the amount of Rs. 360/- to Rs.3,10,000/- and tried to deposit it in the account of complainant Sanjay Sahu.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that he has innocent and falsely implicated in the present case, therefore, he shall be released on bail.
5. On the other hand, counsel for the State opposes the bail application. He further submits that no criminal antecedents against the applicant.
6. Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, looking to the fact that there is no likelihood of the accused to abscond and tamper the evidence, it is directed that if the applicant furnishes two solvent sureties for a sum of Rs. 25,000/- each along with a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- to the satisfaction of the concerned Court with the condition that he shall not involve such type of crime in future, he shall be released on bail.
