The accused/applicant has moved this second bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No. 251/2017 registered at Police Station – Modhapara, Raipur, District Raipur for the offence punishable under Section 20-B of the NDPS Act, 1985.
