Hon'ble Shri Justice P. Sam Koshy**Order on Board****07/01/2019**

1. The petitioner has filed this petition for issuance of direction to respondent-transferring authority to relieve him on the grievance that though the transfer order has been issued by the State Government, till date, he has not been relieved.
2. The issue regarding implementation of transfer order has been considered by this Court in the case of ***Ms. Manisha Agrawal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh and Others, 2015(4) C.G.L.J.182***, wherein relying upon several judgment of the Supreme Court, it has been held by this Court that once the employee has been transferred, it is required to be complied with unless it is modified, varied or cancelled by the State Government itself.

3. Therefore, in these circumstances, this petition is disposed off with the direction that petitioner shall be relieved forthwith by the controlling authority in compliance of order (Annexure P/1) unless the State has not modified, varied or cancelled the impugned transfer order.
