1. Offence punishable under Sections 420, 466, 467, 471 read with Section 34 of the IPC were registered against the applicants herein by the jurisdictional criminal Court against which they preferred a revision but that was dismissed and learned Chief Judicial Magistrate issued arrest warrant against them but the applicants

had already been admitted to the privilege of anticipatory bail granted by this Court on 13/12/2018 in MCRCA No. 1443 of 2018.

In view of the above, applicants are at liberty to inform the Chief Judicial Magistrate that they have already been extended the privilege of anticipatory bail and may pray for recall of warrant of arrest that has already been issued by providing a copy of the order granting anticipatory bail.
