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PER COURT :-

1. Learned counsel appearing for petitioners, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise the objections as are raised in the petition at the appropriate time.

2. Learned Counsel for respondent submitted that hearing of the suit filed by the present respondent is being unreasonably delayed at the instance of the petitioner.
