By order dated 21.06.2018, this Court allowed Review Application No. 30/2018 preferred by the applicant and restored the petition for hearing, as the Grievance Committee under the Maharashtra Universities Act was not constituted with the Pune University.

2. By way of present application for amendment, the applicants are intending to bring on record the copy of the order delivered by the Grievance Committee, as it is claimed that the order of the Grievance Committee is not taken to its logical end by the Management.

3. Since the amendment is based on subsequent development,
