PER COURT:

1] Appellant and respondent nos. 1 to 4
are present with their respective advocates
and tendered the consent terms / terms of
compromise. The same are taken on record and
marked as 'X' for identification.

2] Learned counsel for the parties submit that respondent no.5 is no more alive. Parties present, admit their respective signatures / thumb impressions over the terms of compromise. The terms of compromise are also signed by the advocates representing the parties.
