1 I have heard the learned counsel for the applicants.

2 It is submitted, on instructions, that each of the applicants would deposit an amount of Rs.25,000/- (a total amount of Rs.50,000/-) before the Trial Court, in RCS No.11/2012, within two weeks from today, provided the Court grants extension of time up to 30.3.2019.

3 As per the statement made on the presentation form, learned Advocate for respondent Nos.1 to 5 has been served. His name is shown on the daily board. None appears for respondent Nos.1 to 5.

4 It is informed that, the suit involves immovable property and if these applicants do not get an opportunity to participate in the said Suit, they would lose a valuable right and an irreparable loss would be caused.

5 In view of above, this application is partly allowed by permitting the applicants to deposit costs of Rs.25,000/- each and file their written statement, on or before 30.3.2019, before the Trial Court
