Mr. Surwase the learned counsel submits that the petitioner has an appellate remedy against the order impugned in the present matter.

2. Mr. Dhorde the learned senior advocate on instructions submits that the petitioner would avail the remedy of appeal and the impugned order be continued for a period of four weeks. The amount of Rupees Fifty Lakhs be transmitted to respondent no.4.

3. In light of the above, the writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to avail the appellate remedy. All contentions kept open. The interim relief passed by this Court earlier shall continue for a

period of three weeks from today so as to afford an opportunity to the petitioner to avail the necessary relief from the appellate forum. Needless to state that on lapse of three weeks the protection granted by this Court shall come to an end. The amount of Rupees Fifty Lakhs deposited by the petitioner shall be transmitted to respondent no.4. The same is without prejudice to the rights and contentions of either parties.

4. Writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Civil application also stands disposed of.
