1. The petitioners have challenged the order dated 02/02/2019 passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer. Considering Schedule E under Section 247 of the MLR Code, the petitioners have a statutory remedy of approaching the Additional Collector.

2. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioners to avail of the statutory remedy. If such a proceeding is filed within four weeks from today, the time spent by the petitioners in this Court from 26/02/2019 would be considered as a ground for condonation of delay,

provided the revenue authority has the power to condone such delay under the MLR Code.
