PER COURT:

1. The petitioners have a statutory remedy of preferring a second revision before the State in view of the judgment of the Honourable Apex Court in the matter of *Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra and others, 2015 AIR SCW 6277*. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off.

2.
