Heard the learned advocate for the applicant-appellant and the learned A.G.P. None appears for the respondent no.2-Acquiring body. There is a delay of 1029 days in preferring the First Appeal against the order passed by the Reference Court.

2] Considering the grounds mentioned in the Application and the fact that the applicant-appellant is an agriculturist whose land has been already acquired, coupled with this fact and on the basis of the statement made by the learned advocate that the acquiring body has also preferred Appeal against the same award, the delay is condoned. Application is allowed, subject to the condition that the applicant-appellant shall not be entitled to claim any interest for the period of delay of those 1029 days.
