PER COURT :

1. By this civil application, the petitioner seeks an amendment to the writ petition. The petition is yet to be admitted.
2. The learned Advocate appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 submits that an affidavit in reply has already been filed in the petition and he therefore strongly opposes the said application.
3. Since the petition is yet to be admitted, it would not cause prejudice to the respondents, if liberty to amend the petition is granted with certain conditions.

4. As such, this civil application is allowed.
