**PER COURT:-**

1. Mr. Mali, the learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that respondent No. 3 & 4 had forwarded the proposal to the Education Officer (Secondary) seeking approval to the appointment of petitioner. However, the same is not yet decided.
2. The learned Addl. G. P. accepts notice for respondent Nos. 1 & 2. Mr. Rodge, learned Counsel accepts notice for respondent Nos. 3 & 4.
3. Civil Application is filed contending that it was the right of the applicant to get the appointment. However, the writ petitioner is appointed illegally.

4. It is for the Joint Director of Education to consider all the relevant aspects of the matter while considering grant of approval. As the proposal is pending with the Education Officer (Secondary) seeking approval to the appointment of petitioner. We direct the Education Officer (Secondary) (Respondent No. 2) to decide the said proposal on its own merits, in accordance with law, expeditiously and preferably within a period of six (06) months from today. Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

5. In view of the disposal of the Writ Petition pending Civil Application does not survive and the same is also disposed of.
