PER COURT :

1 Present application has been filed for getting delay of 1468 days condoned in filing First Appeal. The State is challenging the Judgment and Award passed by the learned reference Court. Learned Advocate Mrs. L.R. Thakur holding for learned Advocate Mr. L.C. Patil for the respondent Nos.1 and 2 strongly objects.
