1 This matter is heard for some time and after considering the entire submissions of the learned advocates for the respective sides, there was a consensus that the directions in clause "B" issued by the Appellate Court vide judgment dated 05.02.2019 in Miscellaneous Civil Appeal No.53/2017 and clause "3" of the order dated 28.08.2017 passed by the Trial Court below exhibits 5 and 18 in RCS No.851/2016, would be maintained and respected and at the same time, the respondent/ original plaintiff shall also refrain from interfering with the peaceful possession of the property presently held by the petitioner.

2 In the light of the above statements, this Writ Petition is disposed off. The Trial Court would decide RCS No.851/2016 as expeditiously as possible and preferably on or before 30.06.2020.
