The appeals are preferred being aggrieved and dissatisfied by the award passed by the Member, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. There is delay of 60 days in preferring appeal.

2] The learned advocate for the applicant/appellant submits that since it is the insurance company who was unable to comply with the procedural aspects, the delay has occasioned which may be condoned.

3] The learned advocate for the respondent/original claimant opposes the request. The respondent no.4 the owner has been duly served but has not appeared.
