PER COURT:-

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner, who is the original plaintiff, has filed the application Exhibit 85 in pending Regular Civil Suit No. 120 of 2011 for interim possession of the suit shop. It appears that in the suit seeking the relief of declaration and permanent injunction, this application Exhibit 85 has been submitted for interim possession.
