By inviting our attention to order dated 07th January, 2019 passed by this Court, then to communication dated 05th April, 2019 forwarded to learned Joint Secretary, Law and Judicial Department as well communication to the Panel Counsel of State, Mr. Yenge, learned Counsel for applicant submitted before us that procedural steps were taken by applicant to seek

opinion and advise. Mr. Yenge further submitted that opinion is forwarded by learned Counsel for State to take appropriate step by filing review petition. Mr. Yenge then submitted that in view of the opinion, applicant has also filed review petition. On these grounds applicant prayed for extension of period by three months.

3. Mr. Sabnis, learned Counsel for Respondent No.2/original petitioner opposes the application.
