PER COURT :

1. We have heard Mr. Kulkarni, learned Counsel for the petitioners. The learned Counsel submits that after this Court granted interim order, the respondents have issued the order to the petitioners accepting their service upto 31/03/2020. They were directed to follow the same guidelines incorporating the office order dated 17th January 2019.
