1 Despite service of Court notice through paper publication, none appears for the respondent.

2 This Court has granted ad interim relief to the applicant on 27.6.2018.

3 The applicant submits that, she was earlier assaulted in Pandharpur. A complaint was lodged with the Police Women Cell. The respondent threatens the applicant that, he would again assault her, if she is seen in Pandharpur. An adult member of the family has to accompany her. Her brother is residing in Pune and is not available to accompany her.
