The petitioners had earlier filed Writ Petition No. 11504 of 2017.

In the said writ petition this Court passed the following order:

*“8. It is informed that the suit between the parties in relation to the property which is subject matter of acquisition, being Regular Civil Suit No. 432 of 2016, is already pending in the court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Beed. Since the issue raised before the competent authority by the petitioners is already under consideration of the Civil Court in a pending civil suit, it is desirable that the instant reference shall be assigned to the same judge who is dealing with Regular Civil suit No. 432 of 2016. The Principal District Judge may pass appropriate orders in the matter accordingly.*

9. *The Court dealing with the objections shall decide the dispute after recording evidence of the parties as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of one year from the date of receipt of reference.*

10. *The application for disbursement of the amount deposited by the competent authority, that would be presented by the respondents or the petitioners, shall be dealt with the appropriate orders shall be passed by the Court dealing with the reference as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of three months from the date of tender of the application.”*

2. The parties would certainly be governed by the order which is already passed by this Court amongst the parties in Writ Petition No. 11504 of 2017 dated 20.09.2017. The Court and parties shall adhere to the said order and decide the proceedings expeditiously. Writ petition accordingly disposed of. No costs.
