PER COURT :-

1 The learned advocate for respondent No.2 to 4 submits that, an alternate remedy is available to the petitioners, to prefer a Second Revision, in the light of the Judgment of the Honourable Apex Court delivered in the matter of **Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani versus State of Maharashtra and others** (2015 (6) Mh.L.J.915).

2 The learned Advocate for the petitioners submits that the time spent by the petitioners in this Court from 12.6.2018 may be considered as a ground for condonation of delay, if the petitioner approaches the revisional authority.

3 In view of the above, this petition is disposed off.

4 If the petitioners approach the revisional authority by filing

second revision, within four weeks from today, the time spent by the petitioner in this Court from 12.6.2018 until four weeks from today, would be considered as a good ground for condonation of delay.
