7 The Appellate Court shall thereafter, endeavour to deliver its judgment in the said appeal as expeditiously as possible and preferably on or before 30.06.2019.

8 Needless to state, the Appellate Court would decide the appeal on its own merits and without being influenced by any observations appearing in the interlocutory order passed by the said Court.
