PER COURT :

1. Present application has been filed for getting the delay of 68 days condoned for bringing the legal representatives of appellants on record.
2. Heard learned advocate appearing for the applicants, respondents and learned advocate are absent.
3. The applicants have contended that, they were not aware about the pendency of the proceedings but then they came to know about the same from the letter issued from the advocate, and therefore, the said delay is unintentional.
