PER COURT :

1 Present application has been filed by the original claimants to get the delay of 847 days condoned in filing First Appeal. The applicants intend to challenge the Judgment and Award passed by the learned reference Court.

2 Learned AGP representing respondent No.1 object to the application on the ground that the delay is huge and inordinate.

3 Taking into consideration the fact that the claimants are illiterate and rustic villagers, whose agricultural lands have been acquired, the delay stands condoned.

4 Application stands allowed and disposed of accordingly.

5 It is clarified that the applicant will not be entitled to get interest for the period of 847 days, in case of success in his First Appeal.

6 Registry to verify and register the First Appeal and place it for further consideration on 05.11.2019.
