Heard Mr Yeramwar, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

2. In response to the notice of this Court, learned Asstt. Govt. Pleader submitted before this Court that on instructions received through the Deputy Director and Member Secretary of Scheduled Tribes Certificate Scrutiny Committee, Nandurbar that due to large number of pendency of the claims and certain validation matters received by the Committee for decision afresh or matters remitted for a fresh decision, the exercise of decision in the claim of present petitioner within stipulated period as directed by this Court, could not be taken.
