PER COURT :

1. The learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the Employees' Provident Fund Office submits that due to oversight, the copies of the petition paper book could not be supplied and as a consequence, the petitions came to be dismissed without issuing notices. 2. Considering the above, these civil applications are allowed.
