ORDER :-

. As far as prayer clause (B) is concerned, today the same may not survive as the petitioner has already attained the age of superannuation. The period can only be considered notionally depending upon the decision taken by the Education Officer.

2. As far as prayer clause (C) is concerned, it appears that the petitioner has already approached the Education Officer (Secondary) by filing application (Page 42). The Education Officer (Secondary) shall consider the record and take decision with regard to the claims made in the application dated 21.01.2019 (Page 42) after hearing the

petitioner and Management. The parties are at liberty to place the documents on record before the Education Officer on which they rely. The parties shall appear before the Education Officer on 12 December 2019. The Education Officer shall after considering the record, take decision upon the claims made by the petitioner on its own merits, preferably within four months from the date of appearance.

3. Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of. No costs.
