FINAL ORDER :

. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, the appeal has been filed in the year 2011, however, no further progress has been made.

2. The learned Assistant Government Pleader accepts notice for the respondent No. 4.

3. If an appeal is filed before the Presiding Officer, School Tribunal, School Tribunal is expected to deal with the appeal expeditiously. The parties are also required to co-operate for expeditious disposal of the appeal.
