O R D E R

1. These are the first appeals (stamp) filed by Acquiring Body namely, Executive Engineer, Medium Project Latur. The Acquiring Body is represented today by learned Advocate Mr. B. R. Surwase along Shri Vishnupant Jewalikar, Executive Engineer, Lower Terna Canal Division No.2, Latur and Mr. A. M. Phule and Mr. S. S. Dande, learned AGP for the respondent -State.

2. The Acquiring Body after verification and necessary calculations has made statement that the decretal amount granted by reference Court is well within the parameters fixed under the Government Resolution dated 3rd November, 2016 and Corrigendum issued in respect of the said Government Resolution, and therefore, the acquiring body is ready to accept the award passed by the Reference Court in the References filed by the respondent/claimants under Section 18 of the Act, 1894.

3. The officer present on behalf of the Acquiring Body undertakes
