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PER COURT :-

1. Issue involved is with regard to the mutation entry. By the impugned order, delay of 25 years is not condoned.

2. The petitioners have a statutory remedy by approaching the second revisional forum in view of the judgment of the Honourable Apex Court in the matter of Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani vs. State of Maharashtra and others, [(2016) 2 SCC 213].

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that if the period consumed in the pendency of this petition is considered as a good ground for condonation of delay, the petitioners would approach the second revisional authority.

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4. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off with liberty to approach the revisional authority. The time spent by the petitioners in this Court from 14.12.2017 till the passing of this order, would be a ground for seeking condonation of delay.
