**PER COURT:**

1. This matter was not on board. A motion was moved at 10.30 a.m. indicating that the applicant desires to withdraw this application. Hence, taken on the production board.
2. Considering the above, this application is disposed off as withdrawn.
3. By an order dated 11/10/2019, this Court had sought a report with regard to the conduct of the bailiff since it was *prima facie* found that he had erred in not serving the respondent husband despite the detailed address being mentioned. The learned Joint Civil Judge Senior Division,

Aurangabad has submitted a report dated 18/11/2019 indicating that the bailiff had faltered in not properly serving the notice on the respondent.
