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PER COURT :-

1. The petitioner has challenged an order of the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, dated 9.10.2014, passed under Section 101 of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act. The learned AGP points out that the petitioner is already before the revisional authority for assailing the notice of attachment received by the petitioner on 6.6.2018.

2. Though the learned Advocate for the petitioner has strenuously canvassed that this Court would entertain this petition, I find that the petitioner has a statutory efficacious remedy under Section 154 read with sub-section 2A of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act.

3. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off. If the petitioner prefers a revision proceeding before the competent authority under Section 154(2A) of the said Act, within a period of three weeks

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from today, the time spent by the petitioner in this Court from 20.8.2018 till the passing of this order would be a ground to be canvassed for condonation of delay.
