PER COURT:

1. Mr. Munde, learned counsel for respondent no. 3 / Municipal Council, Gangapur, on instructions, submits that the seal of the petitioner's shop would be de-sealed immediately.

2. In view of the fact that the shop is being de-sealed, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed.

3. It is further submitted that the Municipal Council has passed resolution that petitioner

shall not carry out liquor business in the said shop. The petitioner can challenge the said resolution before the Collector.

4. For a period of 15 days, the Municipal Council, shall not take further action against the petitioner pursuant to its resolution.

5. Writ Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
