3. The petitioners have to file an application with respondent no.3. It does not appear that the application has been filed with respondent no.3. The application seems to have been filed with the Collector.

4. The petitioners may file a comprehensive application with respondent no.3. The respondent no.3 on receipt of application from the petitioners shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law

after hearing all the parties concerned preferably within nine months from the date of receipt of the application. Writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
