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PER COURT :

1. None present when called out in the first session. After a pass over, this matter was called out at about 3.50 p.m. None present for the petitioner.

2. The learned AGP submits that this matter pertains to the 'no confidence motion' having been passed against the petitioner Up-Sarpanch. He was elected as a member of the Village Panchayat, Badnapur in October, 2010 and later on became the Up-Sarpanch in the first meeting in November, 2010. He suffered a 'no confidence motion' on 12/06/2014. Therefore, the learned AGP submits that the term of the petitioner, even as a member of the Village Panchayat, has

ended in November, 2015 and this matter is rendered infructuous.

3. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off as being infructuous.
