PER COURT :-

1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned AGP for the respondents-State. It appears that the petitioner has a remedy of an appeal under Section 6-B(3) of the Maharashtra Home Guards Act.

2. In light of the above, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

3. Petitioner may take steps as may be permissible under law. It is made clear that the authority may only consider the period of pendency of the Writ Petition while considering the application, if any, however, the petitioner has to explain about the period prior to the filing of the petition for delay.
