FINAL ORDER :

. In the present matter, the caste certificate is confiscated by the Committee on the ground that the spelling of the Tribe in the Caste Certificate is erroneously spelled.

2. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

3. The petitioner may make an application to the Committee for issuance of the attested Tribe Certificate of the caste certificate submitted by the petitioner to the Committee with incorrect spelling. The attested copy shall be issued by the Committee within 7 days from the date of application made by the petitioner. The petitioner shall submit the said attested copy of the Tribe Certificate with the S. D. O. The petitioner shall also make online application to the S. D. O. The concerned S. D. O.

after verifying the genuineness of the attested Tribe Certificate submitted to it, shall issue the tribe certificate with the correct spelling of the tribe to the petitioners within 15 days thereafter. The petitioners may file online application to the S. D. O., if required.

4. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of. No costs.
